

# Shadow Star™

*Libertia paniculata* 'LPP01' (b)

## STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

### An improved form of a popular Australian Native with wider, darker green foliage

- Shadow Star™ *Libertia* has a wider leaf, and also has a darker green shiny leaf.
- Larger, cleaner white flowers throughout spring.
- The Shadow Star™ plant is an excellent native alternative for those light to moderately heavy shaded areas.

<b>Description</b>	Wider weeping foliage, clean white flowers
<b>Density</b>	4-6 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 2-4 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	30-40 cm x 40-50 cm
<b>Flowering</b>	White flowers in spring
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	September - April
<b>Uses</b>	Mass planting, cottage gardens, containers
<b>Position</b>	Light - Moderately heavy shade; light frost & moderate drought tolerance once established
<b>Soil Type</b>	Most soil types, prefers moist with moderate drainage
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; prune early August if required
<b>Where it Works</b>	NSW, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
