- Sweet Burst™ Callistemon is a semi-compact fine leaf Callistemon that is great as a feature plant or for mass planting and hedging.
- Its pretty baby pink flowers add a soft burst of colour in Spring, and contrast beautifully with its dark green foliage.
- It has good frost and drought tolerance once established, and will tolerate full sun to partly shaded positions.
- Great for attracting bees and native birds.
- It is a low maintenance Callistemon that requires little to no pruning to maintain a tidy form, but can be pruned yearly to encourage a denser habit.

Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Plant in a well mulched garden (chunky mulch is recommended). If required use slow release fertiliser in spring. If ever required, prune every 3-4 years for a natural shape, or every 2 years for a tidy hedge.
