

The perfect screen or hedge when minimal maintenance is required.

- Sweet Privacy™ Murraya needs less pruning than the common form—only twice a year as a screen, or up to three times a year for a very tight hedge.
- Makes a good fence high or head high screen with the added benefit of sweet smelling, beautiful white flowers.
- It will reach 1.8 to 2.5 metres high depending on the soil condition and planting rate.
- In the image above, in the left foreground, Min a Min is shown growing smaller than Sweet Privacy™ Murraya. The Sweet Privacy™ plant is low maintenance, but it is also large enough to make a great screen. Just the perfect height for the landscape.

Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use slow release fertiliser yearly; prune twice per year, or up to 3 times a year for very tight hedging
