# Pink Fusion<sup>™</sup> Scaevola spp. 'PFS200' Intended

Pretty yet tough flowering ground cover.

- Long-life (survived 12 years of testing). •
- Outcompetes weeds.
- •
- Flowers almost all year round. Tough flowering plant perfect for landscape use.
- Suitable for ground cover.

Description	Long-lived landscape plant with magestic pink flowers.
Density	1-2 plants per m <sup>2</sup>
Height & Width	30cm H x 1.2m W
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	March-November
Position	Tolerates heat and cold extremes. Sun to light shade.
Soil Type	Most soil types. Even handles poor soils
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Trim once a year to keep tidy.
Where it Works	Likely Australia-wide







### **Ozbreed Zen Grass®** Zoysia spp. 'ZOYO1' (b) Intended

# A low-maintenance, fast spreading alternative to traditional lawns.

- Japanese Lawn Grass Zoysia ssp. is tough with less dropouts.
- Less weed invasion due to denser growth. Most weeds can be sprayed out selectively.
- Fast spreading.
- Has a nice, wavy look.
- Only needs to be mowed once every 1-2 years.

Description	A Japanese garden style lawn, that is easy to preserve
Density	For fast coverage, 7-9 per m2 7-9 per linear metre
Height & Width	10-20cm H x 1m W
Best Planting Time	Spring through to autumn
Uses	No or low mow lawn alternative, garden understory, Japanese garden
Position	Extremely tolerant to drought, frost and heat. Wear tolerant. Survived floods. Tough in shade
Soil Type	Low fertiliser requirements
Care	Water for 4-8 weeks until established
Where it Works	Likely Australia-wide Trial in QLD and ACT Trial in QLD and ACT









# Eskdale Blue<sup>TM</sup> Poa spp. 'POL12' () Intended

Tough and elegant landscape plant that requires no fuss

- A low-maintenance plant. Lovely arching foliage. Tidy, and compact form. •

Description	Hardy landscape plant, with bluey-green foliage.
Density	4-10 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 2-4 per linear metre
Height & Width	45cm H x 45cm W
Best Planting Time	March - October
Uses	Roadside and mass plantings.
Position	Drought and frost resistant
Soil Type	Wide range of soil types.
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Cut back annually to 15cm above the ground in autumn or late winter
Where it Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA, & WA







# **Rustic**<sup>TM</sup> Poa spp. 'POL11' () Intended

Compact, clean, & no fuss. Perfect for mass plantings.

- A low-maintenance plant. •
- Tidy, compact form providing clear line of sight. Lovely green foliage •

Description	Fine, green arching foliage
Density	4-10 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 2-4 per linear metre
Height & Width	45cm H x 45cm W
Best Planting Time	March - October
Uses	Roadside and mass plantings. Great as a border
Position	Full sun to part shade. Tolerates frost & drought.
Soil Type	Wide variety of soils
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Cut back annually to 15cm above the ground in autumn or late winter.
Where it Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA, & WA







### Ozbreed Flat White™ Pandorea jasminoides 'PJ01' (b

Ozbreed Flat White™ Pandorea is a dense, compact climber perfect for narrow spaces

- With masses of pure white flowers and more compact, dense foliage, this climber is ideal for narrow spaces.
- It can be pruned down to 2 metres high and 40 centimetres wide, only needing pruning twice a year.
- Without pruning, it can reach up to 2 metres wide.

Description	More dense, compact climber
Density	1-3 per linear metre
Height & Width	2–3m x 40–60cm pruned; 80cm–2m wide unpruned
Flowering	Pure white flowers from late spring to summer
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	As a climber for covering fences and trellises, ideal for narrow spaces
Position	Full sun to part shade; Moderate frost tolerance, drought tolerant
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeeks until established; prune a few months after planting; prune twice per year for a narrow tight climber
Where it Works	South QLD, NSW, VIC, TAS, SA & WA











# Velvet Sky<sup>™</sup> Metrosideros collina 'MB01' ⊕

A compact Metrosideros with amazing inky blue stems

- Velvet Sky<sup>™</sup> Metrosideros has amazing inky blue stems that almost appears as though they have been dyed blue!
- Stunning blue/green velvet foliage.
- The Velvet Sky™ plant has a dense growth habit making it an excellent choice for hedging.
- It produces beautiful red staminate flowers that contrast with its blue foliage.
- For even more vibrant blue stems, plant in a lightly shaded area

Description	Compact Metrosideros, inky blue stems
Density	1 plant per 1-5 m² 1 plant per 0.5-2 linear metre
Height & Width	2-4 m x 1-3 m (can be smaller in cooler climates)
Flowering	Red flowers in spring
Best Planting Time	September - November
Uses	Hedge, small screen, specimen plant
Position	Full sun to light shade; Light - moderate frost & moderate drought tolerance once established; Salt tolerant
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; prune once per year for tidy hedge
Where it Works	Sth QLD NSW, VIC, SA & WA (Protect from frost in cooler climates)
