HARDY EXOTIC PLANTS

A versatile and resilient shrub/tree for summer shade and winter sun.

- Abundant, lively pink flowers on deep burgundy foliage.
- Wide top spreads out like a roof forming a useful shade canopy.
- Drought-tolerant and has grown in heavy soils in a periodic wet spot.
- Versatile, can be pruned to grow as a hedge, feature shrub, or small tree.

| Description | Deep burgundy foliage that lightens slightly towards the end of summer |
| Height & Width | 2m H x 2m W with pruning |
| Flowering | Vibrant pink flowers in summer and autumn |
| Best Planting Time | Spring or summer |
| Uses | Hedge, feature shrub/tree, summer shade canopy |
| Position | Full sun to part shade Tolerates drought, cold, and frost |
| Soil Type | Well-drained, medium to heavy soils |
| Care | Prune minimally in winter for density, fertilize with slow release or manure-based fertilizers, and water well for the first 13 weeks |
| Where it Works | QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA |
