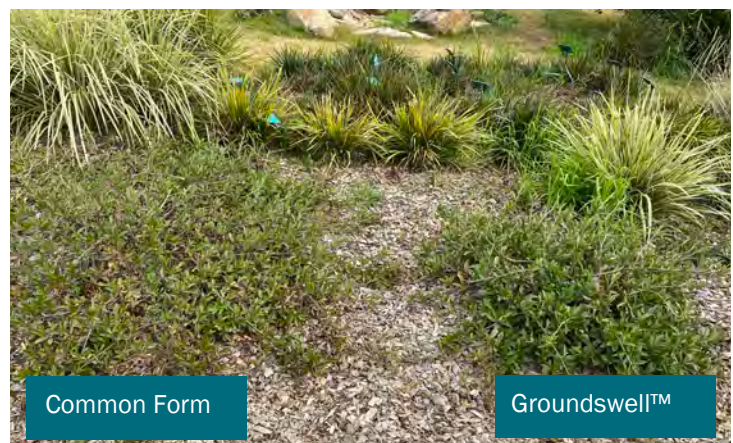
Hibbertia scandens 'HBS01' 

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

Compact, tidy and dense ground cover with less gaps and masses of yellow flowers.

- Drought-tolerant, resilient against heat and humidity, more frost tolerant.
- Salt-tolerant, thriving in heavy sandy soils, the coast, and even salt-laden windy foredunes.
- Less rambling, more compact nature makes it less likely to smother other plants and it's easier to maintain.

Description	Dense ground cover, more compact and tidier form
Density	1-2 plants per m ² 3-4 per linear metre
Height & Width	450mm H x 2000mm spread
Flowering	Sporadically gorgeous yellow flowers from spring to autumn
Uses	Low-maintenance gardens, courtyards, roadsides, containers, cottage gardens, erosion control, coastal landscapes including foredunes, embankments and mass planting
Position	Full sun to part-shade, drought and moderate frost tolerant
Soil Type	From sandy free draining to heavier clay type soils.
Care	Water for first 13 weeks to establish. Use slow release or manure type fertilisers. Trim the climbing form once or twice yearly if a tidy look is desired, or trim every two years as a minimum if used as a climber.
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, VIC, WA, SA. Testing required for ACT and TAS
