Myoporum insulare 'MYINO1' (♣)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

Ultra-flat, weed-suppressing coastal ground cover with ornamental foliage.

- Fine leaves and shorter internodes that make it more ornamental than the common form.
- Excellent weed suppressor due to its dense foliage.
- Highly frost tolerant, making it suitable for inland planting.
- Survives in a range of soil types, including heavier and moderately boggy soils.
- Shows impressive resilience to coastal conditions, including salt-laden winds.



Description	Dense and shiny dark green foliage
Density	1 plants per m2
Height & Width	100mm H x 2000mm W (initially), 200-300mm H x 4000mm+ W (after layering and a decade or two)
Flowering	Small white flowers in spring and early summer, sometimes in autumn
Uses	Ideal for large-scale ground cover, cascading over rocks, roadside and path edge plantings, border plantings, adjacent to rain gardens, or to cover untidy objects. Can be trained to cover specific shapes in designs.
Position	Full sun to part shade
Soil Type	Tolerates most soil types, including heavier soils and moderately boggy soils
Care	Water well for the first 6 weeks, and additional watering may be necessary in the first summer. Responds well to fertilizer and benefits from yearly or bi yearly pruning near borders. Once established, requires minimal maintenance
