Dianella caerulea 'DCNCS' PBR ♂

STRAPPY LEAF

Low-spreading *Dianella* with blue flowers, berries, and dense, dark green strappy leaves.

- Cleanest dark green foliage among low-spreading Australian native *Dianella*s
- Highly ornamental ground cover that protects against erosion and weed invasion
- Resilient and cost-effective with quick rejuvenation and repair capabilities



Description	Low-spreading <i>Dianella</i> with dark green foliage.
Density	6-10 plants per m ² for quick establishment and density
Height & Width	300-400 mm high x 600-1000 mm wide
Best Planting Time	Spring or early summer for optimal establishment and growth.
Uses	Ideal for erosion control, soil stabilisation borders roadsides, low line-of-sight areas, green roofs, rockeries, fire-retardant landscapes, raised and planter box ground covers, and adjacent to fences and driveways. It can withstand being driven over occasionally, perfect for roadsides.
Position	Full sun to moderate shade
Soil Type	Tolerates heavy, damp, and sandy soils; resilient in a variety of challenging conditions.
Care	Requires occasional mowing or pruning to 30cm to 50cm from the ground; fertilise at establishment and occasionally for improved appearance
Where it Works	Performs well in QLD, NSW, VIC, TAS, SA, and WA.
