

# Aussie Reflection

*Chrysocephalum apiculatum* 'CAP07' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

Australian wildflowers that survive where others don't.

- Yellow buttons that keep living where others die
- Stolons spread and help it bounce back from stress
- Recovers after drought and frost



**Description** This *Chrysocephalum* has stolons that spread and bounce back from conditions other wildflowers can't survive. It's a complete game-changer for Aussie landscapes.

**Density** 3-6 per sq m or 4 per linear metre.

**Height & Width** 200mm H Foliage, 350mm H flowers, 500mm+ W

**Flowering** Vibrant yellow flowers for most of the warmer months, feed native pollinators, while seeds feed other beneficial insects and more.

**Best Planting Time** Late winter to spring

**Uses** Native ground cover, biodiversity support, retaining walls, containers. Supports warm, containers, coastal palettes, green roofs, wildflower meadows

**Position** Full sun to light shade.  
Tolerant of frost and drought.

**Soil Type** Most soils, but looks best with adequate drainage.

**Care** Allow adequate drainage and irrigation during dry periods. Prune back when conditions improve.

**Where It Works** NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA, WA, QLD (more testing need for north QLD)
